Although Chadwick's international prominence coincided with the Festival of Britain in 1951 and his inclusion in the Venice Biennale of 1952, he emerged from this group of young British sculptors and began to exhibit more widely in Europe and USA. Most importantly the Kassel Documenta of 1955, which featured a group of iron and composition sculptures including this work, led to Chadwick's invitation to the 1956 Venice Biennale where he won the International Sculpture Prize.
